Make the love of lord your pen, and let your consciousness be the scribe. Then, seek the Guru's instructions, and record these deliberations.

(Guru Granth Sahib Ji, Ang 16)

The inspiration and impact of Guru Nanak Dev ji, the founder of world's youngest religion, Sikhism, lies not only in his being the apostle of dharma but also in his role as a "universal teacher" and a "social crusader". In the middle ages that were strife-torn, he sow the seeds of a monotheistic all inclusive philosophy where everyone was given equal respect and place irrespective of his Varna or caste. His social philosophy speaks of "Naam Japna, Kirat Karna and Vand Chhakna", the three pillars of Sikhism. Woman was given the highest place much before the Western scholars even conceived of it. ".

Hence, it is imperative that on his 550th birth anniversary we pay our true respect to the Guru's message of universal love and brotherhood and engage ourselves with the positive role as conscious social beings and strive for the betterment of the society and community at large. - The abstract of the paper in not more than 250-300 words, along with the following information - a) author b) affiliation c) title of the abstract d) email id e) abstract and f) key-words - be mailed to conference2019sgndkc@gmail.com not later than 7th April. 2019. The acceptance of the abstract will be communicated through email within two days of receipt of the abstract.
- Accepted abstracts would be required to submit a full draft-paper in 3000-4000 words, referenced according to the 7th edition of APA stylesheet to be submitted in MS word by 15th April,2019.
