VISIT TO FLAG CHILDREN HOME **Community Outreach Programme**

Theme: Educating children on Solid Waste management

Under the aegis of IQAC, EnviSAGE and Project S.E.V.A organized a community outreach programme on 10th November, 2022. Student members of both societies, alongwith respective teacher convenors visited Flag Children Home, Delhi with the twin objective of imparting environmental education on a contemporary issue and as a gesture of sharing and caring for the underprivileged. The environmental topic that was chosen for the children was Solid Waste Management, on which students planned and prepared various activities.

About the programme

The event started with welcoming all the children of the shelter home, introducing both societies to them as well as briefing them about the purpose of the visit. After this, the children were shown a short documentary on managing solid waste and the importance of waste segregation. Based on the documentary, a quiz was conducted in which all children participated actively. Following the quiz, an activity was also conducted in which the children were taught to design their own colour coded (blue, green, red) dustbins from waste material (used cardboard boxes, newspaper, waste paper etc). Children were encouraged to segregate waste and keep their surroundings clean.

Towards the end, students of both societies distributed gifts and snacks to children.

Outcome

The event was the first environmental education based outreach activity for EnviSAGE society. Students members thoroughly enjoyed their interaction with the children and were very glad to share their knowledge with them. Members of both societies also learnt important skills in planning preparing and executing for an outreach event.
