Udyamita, The Entrepreneurship Cell in collaboration with SOFICA, the society for Financial Literacy and Consumer Awareness organized a series of five events as part of its annual fest Tvesh'18. The Entrepreneurial Bazaar was organized in the college compound where stalls had been put up for the competitors to sell their products. 13 teams from various colleges participated in the event coordinated by Mrs. Silky Jain.

Ruminate, the student panel discussion was based on the idea that "It is better to debate a question without settling it than to settle it without debating it." A total of 47 students from various colleges registered for this event out of which 15 were shortlisted spread over 3 panel discussions with 5 students each. The audience and participants were seated and the judges were facilitated by our teacher coordinators who were very participant throughout the event continuously asking questions related to the topic of the discussion.

JUDGED was a platform where participants experienced the real-life court environment of consumer rights and fights and got the chance to peep into real life cases by being their representatives, fighting for own and thus unleashing the sides still not known. The simulation compelled the participants to scratch their brains and present the heated arguments. It was overwhelming to get huge registrations and participation from students of various institutions.

Finquest-A game of finance was organized which started with a twist in the original dumbcharades wherein some words of finance were thrown and the participants needed to guess it right. The event was a huge success attracting a lot of crowd.

Udyamita organized a treasure hunt on 8th February. Maximum of 2 students could form a team. The students were supposed to follow a series of clues leading to different places inside the college campus to reach the final destination. At each location there was an activity planned for them which they were supposed to complete under the supervision of our teacher coordinator only then they will get the next clue. Clues comprised of puzzles and riddles whereas activities comprised from quizzes to performing tasks. The first team to reach the final destination and completing its task won the treasure hunt.

All in all the event was successful and gained a lot of popularity.
