Activities: The seminar held on February 13, 2024, featured Dr. Devesh Birwal, Assistant Professor at the Delhi School of Economics, University of Delhi, as the guest speaker. Dr. Birwal addressed the theme, "Navigating the Dynamic Landscape of the Indian Economy Since Independence." He highlighted key aspects, including government efforts in the public sector, achievements in globalisation and liberalisation leading to job opportunities, and the impact of new technologies such as high-yielding seeds.

The discussion covered industrialization, economic planning, and massive capital investments in sectors like railways and transportation. Dr. Birwal emphasised government incentives, the shift from the licensing raj to open trade barriers, and India emerging as a global tech hub. The service sector's continuous growth contrasted with a decline in agriculture, though during COVID, the agricultural sector gained importance.

Other notable points included India's leadership in renewable energy, financial inclusion through initiatives like Jan Dhan Yojna, strategic advantages in linking Asia, Make in India, GST implementation, and the formalisation of the economy. Dr. Birwal highlighted India's rapid economic rise from the 11th to the 5th position in the last decade, the role of the Indian diaspora, and the significance of strategic diplomacy, including space diplomacy, in India's policy framework.

Main Ideas	The essence of this seminar was to highlight key aspects of the growth of Indian economy from the ruined and fallen state to being the 5 th largest economy in the world.


