Q4 Mother Courage is a representative of the petite bourgeoisie. In the play her capitulation to circumstances and her compromises are attributed less to her person than to her class. Elaborate.

Q5 Dumb Kattrin , as the most deprived and victimized person , appears to represent the wretched on the earth. Discuss.

Q6 Who is the real mother courage, Kattrin or Anna Fierling ?Give a well reasoned answer.

Q7 Discuss the play as an example of `Epic Theatre.

Q8 Write about the significance of the songs in the play.

Q9 Write short notes on:

- a) Symbolism in the play
- b) Virtues at the time of war

Q10 `A Doll's House`is a feminist play. Give a well reasoned answer.

Q11`A Doll's House` is a criticism of the bourgeois society that limits human rights and puts duty and norm above the person. Do you agree? Give a well reasoned answer.

Q21 Discuss 'Wedding Album' as a play which is funny, poignant and deeply unsettling.

Q22 Mahesh Dattani's 'Final Solutions' discourages communal stereotyping. How? Explain.
