Assignment 1 (25 marks)

Question: Your friend is about to begin her graduation. Write a letter to her delienating the life lessons that you learnt in your college experience.

Answer: Properly write the format of the informal letter

1st Paragraph: Begin by extending greetings to your friend along with your congratulations over her admission in a little detail.

2nd Paragraph: Describe your own college experience in detail and provide suitable information.

3rd Paragraph: Give your suggestions over concerns like studies, food recommendations, important phone numbers, hostel stay etc. End the letter with your best wishes.

Assignment 2 (25 marks)

Question: Prepare a debate either in support or against the topic: Privatization of education is the need of the hour for reaching global standards of education (word limit 300-500 words)

Answer: Beginning with personal stance on the topic (either in for or against the motion) the answer may encapsulate:

- Proper understanding of privatization of education
- Government policies regarding the same and why it has been proposed
- Arguments in support/against the topic
- Facts and figures with regard to the subject
- Its larger social, cultural and economic impact on people
- Examples from personal experience
- Reiteration of the topic with a summary of the entire take on the subject

Test (50 marks)

Prepare a PPT on any one of the following topics:

1. Case study of any one current issue covered by Indian Journalism

Answer: The PPT may include:

- Detailed description of the news piece
- How is Indian media covering it and what asked do they focus upon
- The interesting takes of media on the subject
- Major debates on the topic
- What are the loopholes in their representation
- How are audiences reacting to the news piece
- Larger social impact of the representation of the issue.

2. One story/novel/novella you have read.

Answer: The PPT may include:

- Publication details of the book
- Details about the author and his/her other books
- Description of plot
- Study on characters
- Interesting aspects of the piece of writing
- Main features of the text
- Themes discussed in the text
- Textual arguments and textual evidence to support the same
- Personal opinions
- Comparative analysis with other books of the same genre
