

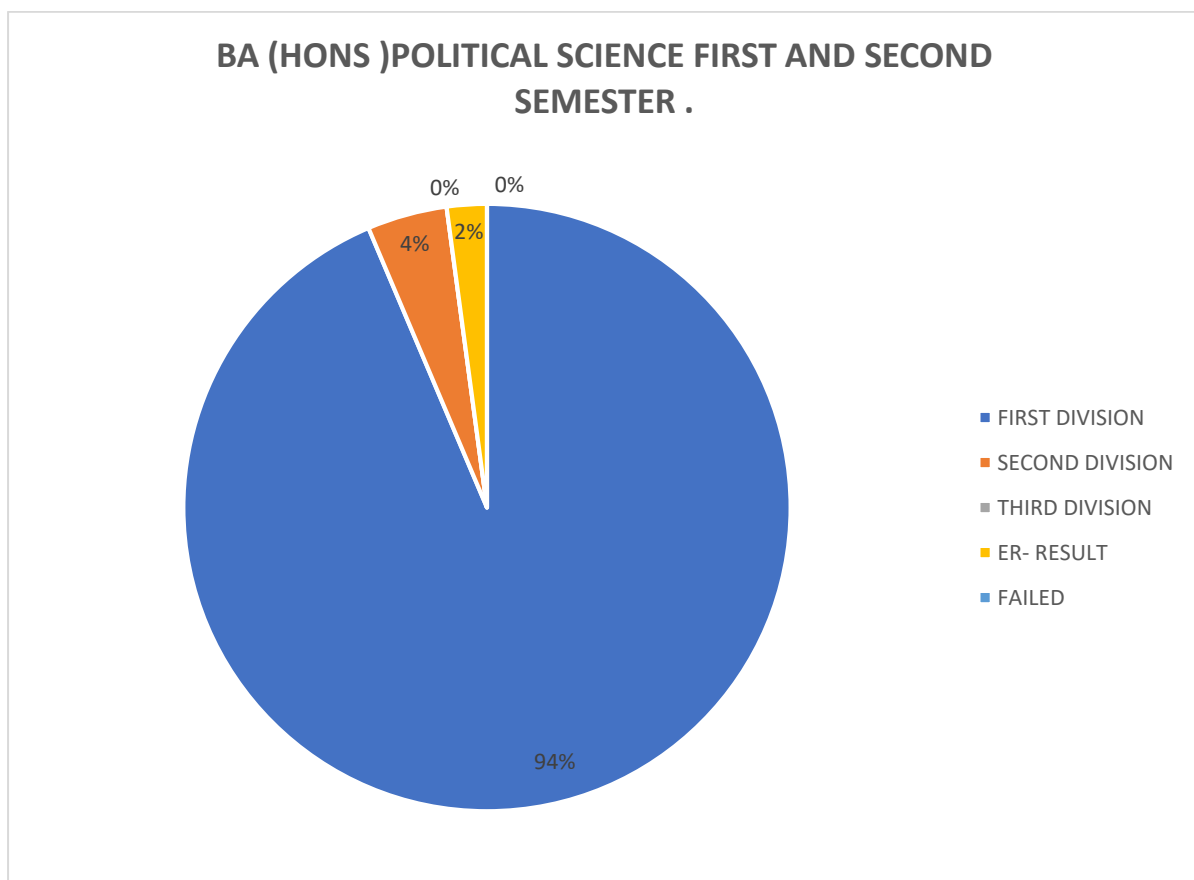
**RESULT ANALYSIS: PROGRAMME NAME: B.A. (HONS.) POLITICAL SCIENCE FOR THE YEAR 2021**

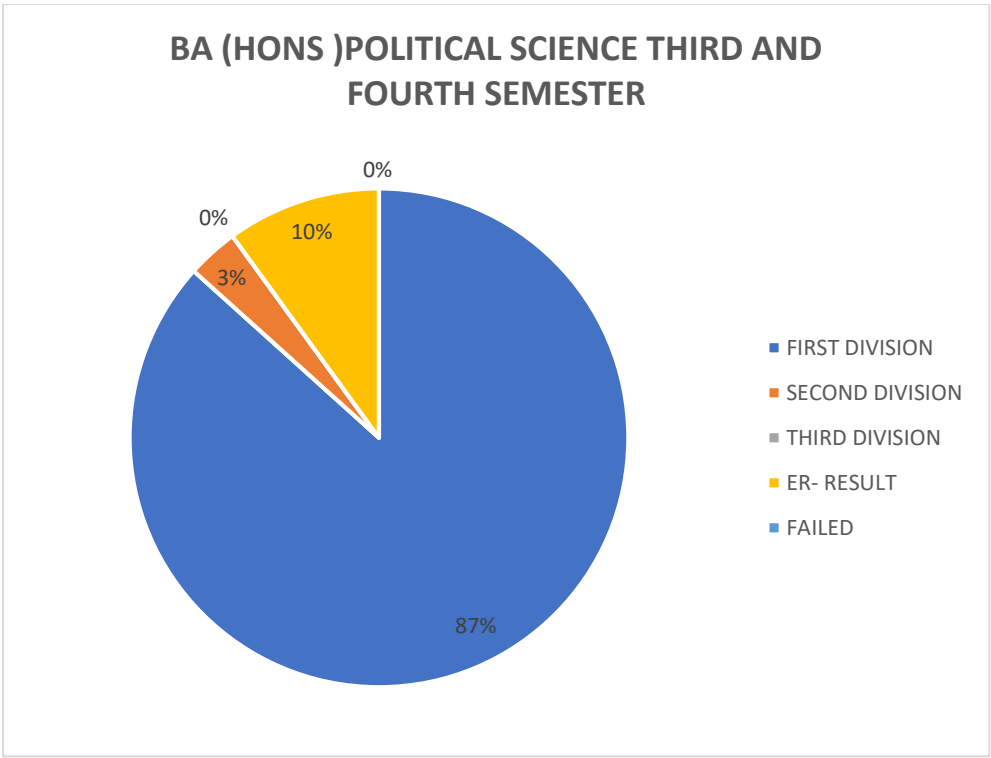

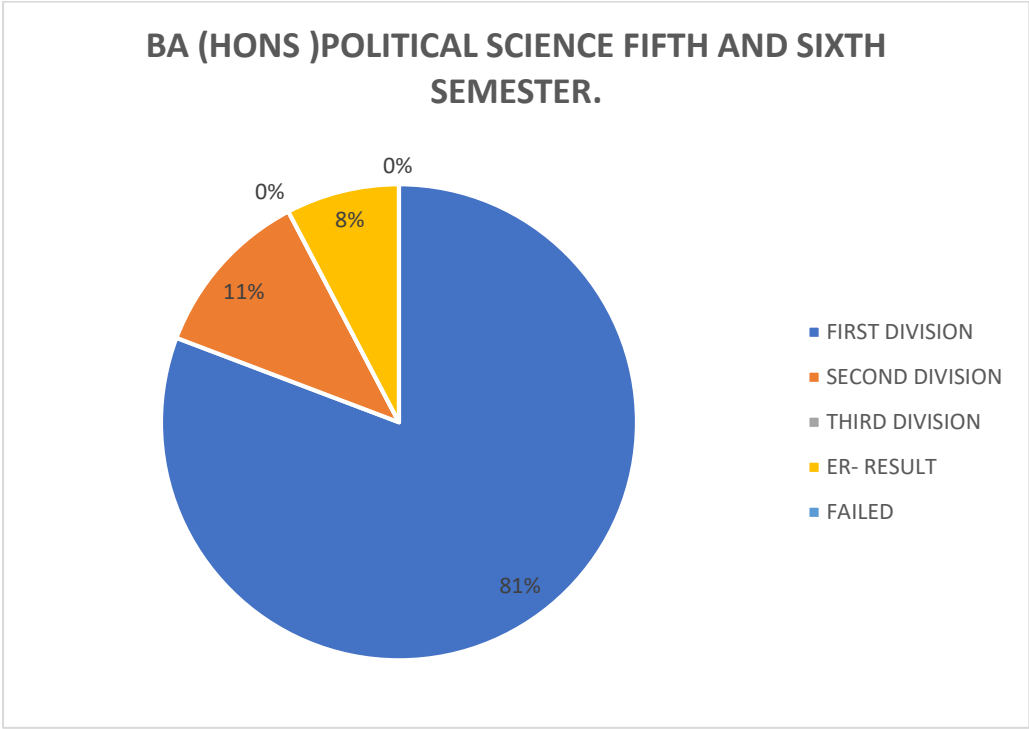
Overall, when the results of all three years are considered collectively, the pass percentage for the year 2021 appears to be quite satisfactory, reflecting a positive academic outcome for the department.
