## **NOTIFICATION**

The University of Delhi is going to conduct the Open Book Examination (OBE) remotely for the final semester/term/year students of all Undergraduate and Post Graduate programmes (including SOL and NCWEB) as one time measure to facilitate the students to take their career forward in the prevailing situation of COVID-19 pandemic. A notification was issued on 15.07.2020 covering the detailed steps and guidelines for the OBE in compliance with the order of the Hon'ble High Court dated 14.07.2020 in W.P. (C) No. 3199/2020.

Further, in compliance of the order passed by the Hon'ble High Court on 05.08.2020 the following points may be noted by all concerned regarding the Open Book Examination (OBE) to be conducted remotely from 10.08.2020 onwards for the final semester/term/year students of all Undergraduate and Post Graduate programmes as one time measure in view of the prevailing situation of COVID-19 pandemic-

- 1. All students (regular, NCWEB and SOL) appearing for the OBE mode of examination shall receive the download link of question papers at their registered e-mail address as per respective date sheets notified on the University website.
- 2. The students who fail to upload the scanned images of answer sheets on the designated portal have been given the alternative facility to send the images of the answer scripts to the e-mail of their respective college and department/centre/faculty as notified on the website on 31.07.2020 and 05.08.2020 respectively along with the details of the Nodal Officers to be contacted in case of any problems faced in the process.
- 3. As already notified on the website on 02.07.2020, those students who for any reason fail to upload the scanned images of answer scripts on the designated portal have been given the facility to send the scanned images of their answer scripts in PDF format through e-mail at <a href="mailto:obescript@exam.du.ac.in">obescript@exam.du.ac.in</a>.
- 4. Further, the University has already constituted a committee to deal and resolve issues related with the scanned images of the answer scripts in PDF format received through e-mail and a notification in this regard has been issued on the website on 04.08.2020.
- 5. As already notified on 15.07.2020, those students who either fail to submit the scanned answer scripts after conclusion of the examinations or could not appear in the First Phase of OBE to be conducted from 10.08.2020 to 31.08.2020 shall be given the opportunity to appear in the second phase of examination to be conducted by the University.
