NOTICE

GUIDELINES FOR ANTI DEFACEMENT IN AND AROUND COLLEGE CAMPUS

In pursuance of the various Acts/judgments of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India which uphold the recommendations of the Lyngdoh Committee, the following "GUIDELINES" are issued to ensure smooth, fair, and democratic elections while preserving the the dignity of the institution and preventing defacement of college property by the contesting candidate/their supporter. These "GUIDELINES" are hereby notified for strict compliance by all the contestants/supporters/students of the college.

The University has declared that any harm to the College property (including but not limited to the walls, buildings, furniture, doors, washrooms), public property around it (including but not limited to the metro stations, outer walls of the college, and public transport), or any private property will be regarded as an act of Defacement and is strictly prohibited.

- 1) All students are strictly required to maintain good conduct along with the sanctity of the College walls & property in and around the campus.
- 2) The college has established a dedicated portal to be accessed through https://forms.gle/xsh5AJzSTJ8ZfCod6 for addressing all issues related to Defacement. Students can report any violation on this portal.
- 3) The students are prohibited from using any other wall other than the designated Walls of Democracy, as this will be considered an act of defacement.
- 4) The students are permitted the legitimate use of electronic media for the purpose of campaigning.
- 5) Canvassing by the students/contestants/supporters through posters, pamphlets, rallies, loud-speakers, vehicles is strictly prohibited in and around the premises.
- 6) The use of dhols, loudspeakers, crackers other such instruments of noise pollution are not allowed in and around the premises of the College, during the election and even after the declaration of election results.
- 7) In the case of impersonating a candidate/supporter/student for the offence of defacement (including the practice of resorting to practice of writing names of candidates with spelling errors), it is the duty of the concerned candidate/ supporter/student to remove it immediately, report the matter with the nearest Police Station within 24 hours, and produce and share the copy of the reported information with the University/College. Failure to do so will result in candidate/supporter/student being liable to pay a fine of Rs 25,000/-, or as is decided by the University/College administration, including facing suspension from College/Department/University, including rustication for a specific period or expulsion from the College, or being debarred from contesting elections.
- 8) Any act of Defacement/Damage to public property and non- adherence to these Guidelines shall amount to gross indiscipline, and will attract consequent punishment provisions under relevant Ordinance of the University.
