EnviSAGE, The Environmental Society of Sri Guru Nanak Dev Khalsa College, organised an interactive Workshop on E-waste management, in collaboration with E-Junki on 11th November 2021.

E-Junki is a CPCB (Central Pollution Control Board) authorized organization as their aim is to conduct awareness sessions in educational institutions to educate people about proper and safe treatment of e-waste and focusing on sustainable ecosystems. The honourable speakers of the event were Mr Aditya Rai (Social Entrepreneur) and Devansh Chopra (Digital marketing) who interacted with the students, educating them on e-waste management and it's hazardous implications. With the help of a powerpoint presentation, segregation of e waste from other wastes and its subsequent management was shown to the students. This was followed up by a Q&A session. The workshop came to a halt, with encouragement for students to bring forward and share the awareness and importance of e-waste management among friends and families, followed up by students who participated in the workshop receiving a certificate by E-junki.

Outcome of the event

The workshop helped students understand the importance of practicing sustainable management of e-waste in their lives. E-junki representatives also proposed to install e-waste bins in the college campus which would encourage students and teachers to discard unwanted, old electronic items in these bins. E-junki would then collect this e-waste and ensure its proper disposal.
