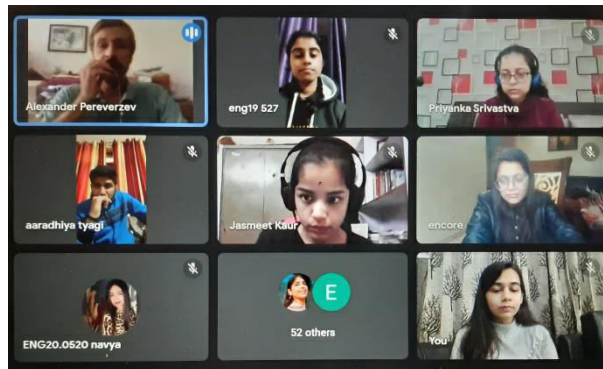

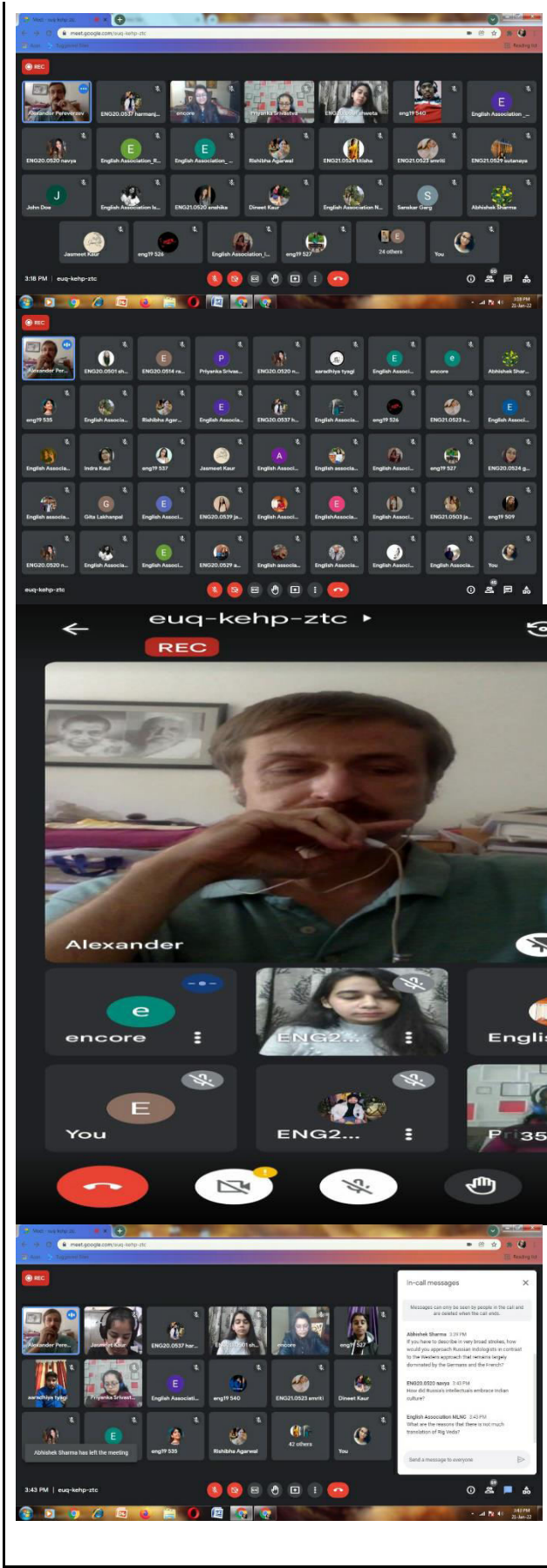
**Speaker: Dr. Alexander
