Essay Writing Competition Report

Gender Sensitization Cell of the College organized an online National level Essay writing competition on gender concerns and gender sensitization in September 2020. Participants could write their essays in Hindi or English languages.

90 entries were received covering a large range of topics like female feticide, position of women in society, legal framework, domestic violence, women's education and security of women. The essays were forwarded to three judges: Dr. Man Mohan Kaur, Former Principal SGND Khalsa College, Dr. KumKum Yadav, Associate Professor(Retd.) Department of English, SGND Khalsa College and Ms. Aparna Dasgupta, graduate of School of Languages JNU. The result was formulated based on their assessment. Ms. Stuti Shree of St. Xavier College, Ranchi won the first prize of Rs. 3100/- and a certificate. Her topic was " From a Father of Angst to the Mothers of Paranoia: Addressing the Prevalent Ignorance Towards Intergenerational Trauma". Ms. Shreya Singh of Janaki Devi Memorial College, Delhi won the second prize of Rs. 2100/- and a certificate. Her topic was "Women in Lockdown".
