Celebrating the Wildlife Week, EnviSAGE, The Environmental Society of SGND Khalsa College, organized the second edition of its flagship competition, **FAUNA SILVESTRE: 2.0 Find a way out**. The objective of this competition is to provide a platform for young students sharing a concern for protecting environment to formulate sustainable solutions to real life problems.

The competition was held in two rounds.

Round 1, **Call for Solutions**

consisted of real-life scenarios based on 5 questions related to wildlife. The participant had to answer only one in no less than 500 words. Based on the content, six participants out of a total of 54 were shortlisted for Round 2.

Round 2, **Into the Wild**

The final round consisted of three questions. The participant was made to attempt one of the three questions and present the same as a 5-minute PowerPoint presentation in front of our judges.

The judges for the event were
