 - He emphasized the importance of proper research and preparation before planning to study abroad.

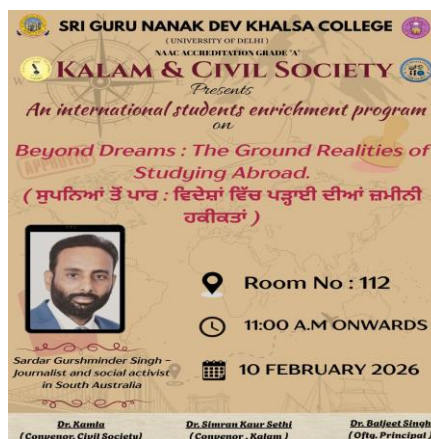


