Workshop on Photoshop for making posters 9th August 2018

Brief Report

Photobug society, in collaboration with Cyberclan organized a workshop on using Adobe Photoshop software on 9 August, 2018. The objective of the workshop was to understand the basics of photoshop software in order to prepare posters for various events. This was particularly useful for cyberclan members as the society provides backend technical support to all other societies and helps them in preparing posters for events.

Mr. Manav Chugh, alumni of Photobug society (batch 2017) was the resource person for the workshop. He is a freelance photographer and has considerable experience in using photoshop software. The event started at 2:00 pm with members gathering in room no 116. Dr. Ashish Thomas, convenor of Photobug society, welcomed all the participants and introduced Mr. Manav to everyone. Following this, Manav shared started with explaining various tools available in the Photoshop CS6 version. A handout mentioning the functions of the various tools was given to all participants. The participants were then asked to make a poster using the knowledge of these tools and clear all the doubts that would crop up in the process. All the members had brought their respective laptops and hence were able to make full use of the hands on training session. A number of doubts arising during the preparation of poster were put forward and the resource person patiently cleared all the queries.

The session ended with the resource person sharing important tips and shortcuts of Photoshop and giving homework on making a poster.
