



Photowalk to Khari Baoli 21st September 2019

Brief Report

Photobug, the photography society, organised a Photowalk to Khari Baoli, Delhi on 21 September, 2019 to capture photographs on the theme of street photography.

Khari Baoli is a street in Old Delhi known for its wholesale grocery. It is Asia's largest wholesale spice market selling a variety of spices, nuts, herbs and food products like rice and tea. The market dates back to 17th century, operating since time of Shahjahan's reign. The street and the market is quite crowded which provides ample opportunity for clicking street photographs.

Members of the society gathered at Chandni Chowk metro station at 3:00 pm. Twelve members participated in the walk. Walking through the narrow lanes and busy streets, they reached the market square. The senior members advised the junior members about the nuances of street photography. Everyone captured a number of photographs that reflected the daily life in these busy streets and market.
