Session Highlights Encore hosted a talk session on Rememory and Resistance in Women's Writing with Dr. Achingliu Kamei, Associate Professor, Department of English at ARSD College, DU. The discussion explored how literature reclaims history and resists marginalization, especially in women's narratives. Ms. Harpreet Bahri and Ms. Nidhi Sharma welcomed Dr. Kamei. Ms Nidhi introduced Dr Kamei's Naga heritage and the role of oral traditions in shaping literary identity. She emphasized how women's literature remains overlooked and how female writers face harsher scrutiny. Dr Kamei gave an insightful analysis of the evolution of Naga literature following independence, highlighting the shift from oral storytelling traditions to written forms as a significant means of resistance. She explained how Naga women challenged patriarchy, even altering grammatical conventions to assert their voices. She read excerpts from Our Song and The Body is a Map, exploring identity, displacement, and resilience. Poetry, she noted, serves as both personal catharsis and collective resistance. The session concluded with Dr. Kamei urging aspiring writers to challenge, inspire, and make a lasting impact through their narratives.
