The lecture aimed to provide students and faculty members with insights into India's evolving role in global politics and international relations in the context of shifting geopolitical dynamics. Prof. Bhardwaj delivered an engaging and thought-provoking talk, highlighting the major transformations taking place in the international system and how India is positioning itself within this changing global landscape. He discussed key strategic, economic and diplomatic factors that influence India's foreign policy and its aspirations as a rising global power.
