On 3rd May, 2020, the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) of Sri Guru Nanak Dev Khalsa College organised a webinar on the topic "NAAC RAF CRITERION-III Research, Innovations And Extension", in collaboration with the IQACs of Anand Institute of Social Work, Anand, and Bhopal School of Social Sciences, Bhopal.
