## **<u>Report on WEBINAR on Role and Functions of IQAC on Revised</u>** <u>Accreditation Framework dated 18<sup>th</sup> July 2020</u>

On 18<sup>th</sup> July, 2020, the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) of Sri Guru Nanak Dev Khalsa College organised a webinar on the topic **"Roles and Function of IQAC as per Revised Accreditation Framework"**, in collaboration with the IQACs of Anand Institute of Social Work, Anand, and Bhopal School of Social Sciences, Bhopal. The webinar was well attended by the staff of all the three colleges.

The program begins with the introductory speech by Dr Ninad Jhala, Principal, Anand Institute of Social work who set the stage for a concrete and inclusive discussion on the topic. The resource person Dr Shyam Singh Inda, Assistant Advisor NAAC, Bengaluru delivered an exhaustive lecture on the role of IQAC and stated that it is the backbone of any institution as it functions solely to monitor, implement, sustain the quality in the functioning of the college.

The main thrust of the presentation was on the quality assurance of the on going efforts to define the objectives of the institution which can only come with the continuous efforts. He specifically mentioned that the RAF demand the documentation of each and every activity so that it can be validated by the authorities.
