Dr. Ashish Thomas, Convenor of the Academic Development Committee, opened the session by warmly welcoming all participants. He highlighted the relevance and importance of organizing the workshop, before introducing the speaker, Ms. Komal, with a brief overview of her role and responsibility entrusted by the University of Delhi, in training faculty members and students on matters related to 4th year research tracks.	
Main ideas Through a well-structured and detailed PowerPoint presentation, the Ms. Komal clearly explained the modalities and implementation of the fourth year under the Undergraduate Curriculum Framework (UGCF). The speaker provided a comprehensive overview of the various components of the curriculum, including the Discipline Specific Core (DSC) and Discipline Specific Elective (DSE) courses, as well as the different academic pathways available to both Honours and Programme students. She elaborated on the credit requirements for students completing the three-year undergraduate degree as well as those opting to pursue the fourth year, enabling participants to understand the academic structure and progression under the NEP. The session also covered the different tracks available in the fourth year, including the Research, Academic Project, and Entrepreneurship tracks, along with their objectives, eligibility criteria, and future academic and professional relevance. The presentation was followed by an interactive question-and-answer session, during which students actively participated by seeking clarifications on various aspects of the curriculum, credit framework, admissions to postgraduate programmes, and career options. The speaker responded to each query in a clear and encouraging manner, making the session highly engaging, interactive, and beneficial for all the participants.
