<p><b>Main ideas</b> The IQAC and Research Committee of the College organized an orientation session for faculty members on 16th October 2025 to enhance understanding of the <i>Guidelines for Supervising Dissertations, Academic Projects, and Entrepreneurship in the Fourth Year of UG Programmes</i> under UGCF 2022.</p> <p>The session was conducted by <b>Ms. Komal</b>, Assistant Professor, Department of Commerce, SGND Khalsa College, who is part of the University's training team for the implementation of the fourth-year curriculum. As the nodal person for monitoring the curriculum and research track implementation at SGND Khalsa College, she shared valuable insights into the objectives, structure, assessment pattern, and timelines associated with each of the fourth-year tracks — <b>Research, Academic Project, and Entrepreneurship</b>. Ms. Komal elaborated on the specific roles and responsibilities of faculty supervisors and provided practical guidance on supervising student projects and dissertations. The session also addressed the modalities of student track selection, evaluation criteria, and documentation requirements.</p> <p>Faculty members actively participated in the discussion and raised pertinent queries related to implementation challenges, assessment standards, and workload distribution, which were effectively clarified by the resource person. The session proved highly informative and helped streamline the faculty's understanding of the new curriculum framework, thereby preparing the departments for its smooth execution in the forthcoming semester.</p>




