She also elaborated on the <b>process of track selection</b>, eligibility criteria, and the documentation required at various stages of the programme.</p> <p>The session further highlighted the <b>nature of research work, project execution, and entrepreneurial engagement</b> expected from students opting for different tracks, along with guidance on planning, time management, and working under faculty supervision. Students actively participated in the session and raised queries related to track suitability, evaluation methods, workload, and future academic or career prospects, all of which were addressed in detail by the resource person.</p> <p>The orientation session proved to be highly informative and helped students gain clarity on the fourth-year curriculum framework, thereby equipping them to make informed decisions regarding their academic progression under UGCF 2022.</p>
