

## Undergraduate Admission 2016-17

### Eligibility Requirements

#### Course: B.A. (Hons.) Punjabi

1	<b>Minimum Percentage Required</b>	A. An aggregate of 45% marks in the qualifying examination. B. Candidates securing 40% marks in the aggregate and 50% marks in the subject concerned are also eligible for admission to this Course.
2	<b>Additional Eligibility</b>	The merit shall be determined on the basis of one language and three best elective subjects. ( <a href="#">List A</a> ) Candidates who have passed the intermediate Examination of an Indian University/Board with at least 40% marks in the aggregate and also Passed of the <b>Gyani- Punjabi</b> examinations be eligible for admission to this Course.
3	<b>Addition of Best of Four</b>	For admission to Punjabi Honours, advantage of 2% in the Best Four percentage may be given to those candidates who have studied that particular elective language.
4	<b>Included non-listed Paper deduction in Best of Four for each Paper</b>	If more than one non-listed subject is included for calculation of 'Best Four', a deduction of 2.5% each in 'Best Four' may be levied.
5	<b>Subject must have Studied</b>	In case, a candidate has not studied a Punjabi language at qualifying exam and is seeking admission to B.A. (Hons.) Punjabi in that deduction of 5% will be imposed on 'Best Four' percentage.
6	<b>Equivalent Paper</b>	NA
7	<b>Language Studied Elective (If included Best of Four)</b>	Advantage of 2% in the Best of Four percentage
8	<b>Language Studied Core (If included Best of Four)</b>	NA
9	<b>Language Studied Functional (If included Best of Four)</b>	NA
10	<b>Paper if Studied but not included in Best of Four</b>	NA
11	<b>Change of Stream</b>	NA
