Areas of Focus: Research

- Establishment of a Research and Development Cell to streamline research efforts by faculty and students.
- Expand the existing database of publication resources, financial assistance, scholarships, and fellowships available nationally and globally to further research of multiple nature in humanities, social sciences, and commerce.
- Provide financial incentive and institutional recognition to faculty members publishing in SCOPUS indexed journals.
- > Organise seminars and workshops to familiarise students with the purpose and focus of the Memory Unit of the institution.
