

## PROVISIONS IN LIGHT OF THE SIKH MINORITY STATUS OF THE COLLEGE

Sri Guru Nanak Dev Khalsa College is maintained by the *Delhi Sikh Gurdwara Management Committee* (DSGMC), a statutory body established under an act of the Parliament of India. The College has been granted Sikh Minority status by the NCMEI of India and ratified by the Honourable Delhi High Court. Fifty percent of the seats of the various courses offered by the college are reserved for students belonging to the Sikh Minority.

1. Sikh students who wish to avail the benefit of Sikh Minority Quota had to mark Sikh Minority in the registration form at the time of registering online through the University of Delhi UG admission portal.
2. Students applying under Sikh Minority Quota are required to get their Sikh Minority Certificate made from the office of **Delhi Sikh Gurdwara Management Committee (DSGMC), Gurdwara Rakab Ganj Sahib, New Delhi - 110 001** before the time of admission. **This certificate is mandatory.**
3. Separate Cut-Off percentages will be announced for Sikh Minority Quota for various courses offered by the college. The Sikh Minority Quota Cut-Off percentage will be applicable only to Sikh Minority Quota applicants who had registered at the University of Delhi as Sikh Minority, uploaded Sikh Minority Certificate at University of Delhi Registration website and have original Sikh Minority Certificate from “Delhi Sikh Gurdwara Management Committee” (DSGMC).
